Todd Clucas will be providing additional data to the Post monthly. Included in the money market account is a CD for \$50,000 which is currently paying a high rate.

1. Homefront America - \$4,000

This is a local charity that supports families from Pendleton. We have given them \$2,500/year since at least 2019. Committee voted 5-0 to approve this request.

2. Vella First Responder Award - \$1,000

This request came from Tim Sullivan. This is a new donation that will be presented to the family of a local first responder chosen by the Fairway of Honors Committee. This year it was presented to Mrs. C. Vella, wife of the Huntington Beach Police Helicopter Pilot who died last year in a helicopter crash. **Committee voted 5-0 to approve this request.**

3. Patriots and Paws - \$2,000

Located in Huntington Beach -hires veterans and helps veterans and active-duty service members with furnishing homes/apartments. Have supported in years past. Committee voted 5-0 to approve this request.

4. Words of Comfort, Hope and Promise - \$3000

Located in San Clemente serving active-duty service members and their families in Southern CA. Committee voted 5-0 to approve this request.
