Committee Meeting: 2022.08.25

Present: Bill Finster, Chris Graham, John Long, Peter Martin, Chris Menninger

The Donation Committee met on August 25, 2022. All five members of the committee voted on the six donations being requested either in person or via e-mail.

Life Aid Research Institute: \$2,500

After discussion of latest information submitted by John Wordin about the program, the committee decided to support the effort. \$5,000 was approved 6-0. Note: After vote a conversation with Tim Sullivan and Cory Vigil it was decided to reduce this request to \$2,500.

- Coastline Community College Veteran Resource Centers: \$5,000
 After a review of the broad range of support that the VRC supports not only student veterans but also supports community veterans (non-students) and incarcerated veterans. They have three locations (Fountain Valley), Garden Grove, and Newport Beach) that are staffed, availability of computers, snacks, and food baskets. \$5,000 was approved 6-0.
- Heroes Deserve Help: \$2,500
 We have supported this group of veterans that rebuild laptops and desk top computers that are then distributed to veterans at no cost. \$2,500 was approved 6-0.
- CarePossible: \$1,000
 Cory recommended this to us for support. This non-profit provides free mental health, and addiction care for veterans and low-income families in Orange County. \$1,000
 was approved 6-0.
- Orange County Rescue Mission Tustin Veterans Outpost: \$5,000 PER Recommended to us by Don Allen. Supplies housing, medical/dental care, meals, and training for veterans living at their campus. \$5,000 was approved 6-0.

A NOTION WAS

• Sponsor Post Veteran 100 Mile Challenge: \$250 Sponsor Jonathon Hermosillo for 100-mile challenge. \$250 was approved 6-0.

To better share with the General Membership meeting, the Committee was wondering if once a quarter, we can find a way to carve 30 minutes out of the normal meeting and have speakers from 2-4 of the charities that we have funded speak about what they do.
